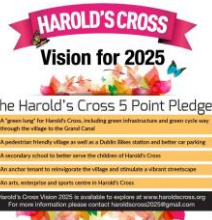

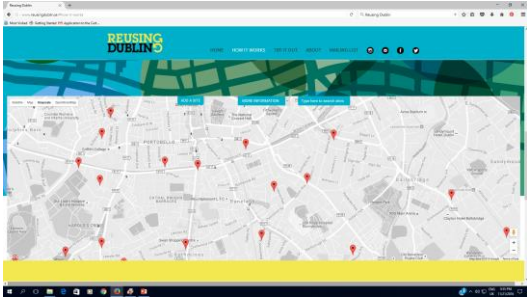

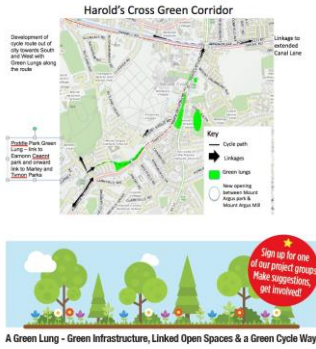

Big Wins 1

• GREEN LUNG - GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE

UPDATE: Potential of Green riverside walkway running through Mount Argus Park through the new Mount Argus Mill development. This could potentially run further south to Sundrive through Mount Argus, explored with DCC.



Green Lung Green Infrastructure contd.

- Potential of Outdoor Gym equipment in Mount Argus Park
- Open space and permeability is monitored by HCVCC in all planning applications lodged.
- Working with Dublin City Council Parks Department in relation to Harold's Cross Park – under discussion upgrading shelters, Green flag, wee library, and Community events, events – yoga, wildlife trail etc.
